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Women University Multan 3rd Convocation

The 3rd convocation of Women University Multan was held on 30th November, 2021. 1768 students were awarded gold medals and degrees at the Convocation held at Mattital Campus. Due to the busy schedule, the Governor Chancellor had delegated the power of awarding degrees to the Vice Chancellor, Women University Multan. At the convocation, degrees were conferred for the first time to 08 PhD scholars of the university including Dr. Sadia Bashir, Dr. Sana Riaz, Dr. Nazia Suleiman, Dr. Mamona Yasmeen, Dr. Fatima Ali, Dr. Hira Ali, Dr. Uzma Sadiq, and Dr. Sonia Iqbal, while 64 students were awarded gold medals, and grand total of 1768 degrees were distributed among the graduates at the convocation.

The chief guest of the ceremony was Ms. Zahida Sarfraz, Commissioner FBR, Multan. Addressing the event, Ms. Zahida Sarfraz said that convocation is a golden day in one's life. This day is meant for fulfilling the dream that people here have seen in the last few years that there should be a higher education institution for women in Southern Punjab.

The government is looking at education sector as a top priority. We are very fortunate that the higher education for which our students had to go to another city is now available in their own city under one roof, due to establishment of Women University Multan. She further said that path of

development is the path of knowledge.

Earlier, Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Quraishi said that in a short span of time the University has been equipped with modern requirements. The university has been declared as world class, because we have successfully tested smart classrooms during COVID-19 which is why we had been able to continue our teaching activities.

There are currently 27 PhD teachers in our faculty. Nine are HEC approved PhD supervisors. We are forming a Council of Students for Curriculum Activities. We have organized 160 seminars for character building. Considering our performance, HEC has approved our PC one, while Punjab Government has also released funds of Rs. 200 million for various projects. In university, new labs and blocks will be established too.

At the end, Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Quraishi distributed souvenirs among the alumni of the college including Ms. Huma Naseeb (SSP) and Ms. Noivera Fahad. The ceremony was attended by Ms. Ehtsham (Secretary Education Southern Punjab), Dr. Qasim Hafeez (Chairman BISE Multan), Dr. Imran Sharif, faculty members and administrative staff.


International Webinar on Dealing with Diversity: Identity Construction, Learning, & Tolerance

28 نومبر 2021ء میں ان کی ولادت کے موقع پر دی ویمن یونیورسٹی ملتان کے شعبہ اُردو نے ان کی خدمات کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے انہیں خراج تحسین پیش کرنے کی غرض سے ایک شاندار تقریب انعقاد کیا گیا جس میں طالبات کی شرکت اور جوش و خروش قابل تحسین تھا۔

بطور پرنسپل اپنی خدمات بحسن خوبی سرانجام دیں۔ ان کے تمام حلقوں میں یہ بات مشہور تھی کہ وہ آزادی کے شاعر ہیں۔

20 نومبر 2021ء کو فیض احمد فیض کے یوم وفات کے موقع پر دی ویمن یونیورسٹی ملتان کے شعبہ اُردو کے اساتذہ اور طالبات نے فیض کی شاعرانہ خدمات کے اعتراف میں ان کو خراج عقیدت پیش کرنے کیلئے ایک پروفان تقریب کا اہتمام کیا جس میں طالبات نے بھرپور شرکت کی۔ اس تقریب میں میقات ہجتم کی طالبہ انصی خلیل نے فیض احمد فیض کی زندگی کے مختلف گوشوں کو سامعین کے گوش گزار کیا۔ اس مضمون میں طالبہ نے بتایا کہ فیض نے پاکستان کے کئی بڑے عہدوں پر کام کیا تاہم اپنی انقلابی طبیعت کے باعث انہوں نے قید و بند کی صعوبتیں برداشت کیں اور جلاوطنی کا عذاب بھی جھیلنا۔ فیض احمد فیض کی 1942ء میں بطور کیپٹن فوج میں تقرری ہوئی تاہم 10 دسمبر 1947ء میں وہ مستعفی ہو گئے۔ 1951ء میں راولپنڈی سازش کیس کے سلسلہ میں انہوں نے 4 سال جیل کاٹی۔ 1955ء میں قید سے رہائی پائی۔ 1959ء سے 1962ء تک فیض نے پاکستان آرٹس کونسل میں بھی بطور سیکریٹری اپنی خدمات سرانجام دیں اور پھر لندن چلے گئے۔ واپسی پر 1964ء میں سعید اللہ ہارون کالج کراچی میں

غالب اور اقبال کے بعد بیسویں صدی کا سب سے نمایاں شاعر فیض احمد فیض مانا جاتا ہے۔ پاکستان کے قیام کے بعد جہاں انہیں اپنی جرأت اظہار اور منفرد انداز بیان کے باعث پاکستان میں مقبولیت حاصل ہوئی وہیں ان کا چہرہ بیرون ممالک بھی خوب ہوا۔ فیض صاحب نے بیسویں صدی میں جب شاعری کا آغاز کیا تو اس وقت ایک طرف تو سب سے اہم اور مقبول شاعر علامہ محمد اقبال ادب کے اُفق پر جگمگا رہے تھے جبکہ دوسری طرف جوش ملیح آبادی اور انتر شیرانی بھی اپنی شاعری کا لوہا منوا چکے تھے۔ اسی شہری فضاء میں فیض نے بھی اپنی شاعری کا آغاز روایتی انداز میں رومانوی شاعری سے کیا۔ ان کی رومانوی شاعری جذبات و احساسات کا حسین امتزاج تھی اس کے بعد ترقی پسند تحریک کے زیر اثر ان کی شاعری نے ایک ایسی تخلیقی جست لگائی جس سے ان کی شاعری کا انداز یکسر بدل گیا اور رومان کے ساتھ ساتھ انقلاب اور عوامی استحصالی رویوں کی مذمت میں ملکی و عوامی لیڈروں کے خلاف باغیانہ پن بھی شامل ہو گیا۔

اس دستاویزی مضمون کے علاوہ فیض کی نظم ”مجھ سے پہلی ہی محبت میرے محبوب نہ مانگ“ کو میقات ہجتم کی ایک طالبہ عقیدہ مریم نے ترنم کے ساتھ پیش کیا جبکہ تنزیلہ رانا نے فیض کی نظم ”ہم دیکھیں گے“ کو فیض تحت اللفظ کے ساتھ بڑی خوبصورتی سے پیش کیا۔

تقریب کے آخر میں شعبہ اُردو کی اساتذہ ڈاکٹر عذرا لیاقت صاحبہ نے فیض کی عصری معنویت پر ایک پرائز گفتگو کی جبکہ صدر شعبہ ہذا صدر نشین ڈاکٹر شاہدہ رسول صاحبہ نے بھی فیض کی اہمیت کو اجاگر کرنے کیلئے جامع گفتگو کی اور طالبات کی کاوشوں کو سراہتے ہوئے ان کی خوب حوصلہ افزائی کی۔
