lecture on “Prevalence of Thalassemia in Pakistan in Comparison with Other Countries and the Steps Taken by Other Countries for the Eradication of Thalassemia”. He explained the various steps that were taken worldwide for the eradication of this disease and proposed that similar strategies should be implemented in Pakistan to reduce the chances of thalassemia major births to zero. Dr. Shabana, Assistant Professor, Dept. of MMG, University of Punjab, Lahore, delivered a lecture on “Benefits of Blood Donation and Safe Transfusion Practices”.

Ms. Uzma Irfan emphasized the importance of blood donation and pre-marital screening test for thalassemia to avoid thalassemia major births after marriage.
